Dear Lucia,

Yes, accommodation must be booked from Saturday to Saturday and classes take place from Monday to Friday. The course week includes several cultural activities – a guided historical walking tour on Monday afternoon and a half-day excursion (either to the Cliffs of Moher or to Connemara) on Wednesday afternoon. We don't organise structured activities on the weekends. However if students are in Galway the Sunday before starting the course many choose to book a tour to one of the surrounding areas of scenic or heritage interest. We work with [Galway Tour Company](#) and if students would like to book one of their tours at the weekend we can offer a discount.

The school and our apartments are located in the city centre, within easy reach of Galway's many restaurants and cafes. There are lots of options to choose from, all within a short walk of the accommodation.
